

Music Bingo 75 How To Play

Music Bingo 75 is a fun and exciting twist on the classic bingo game, with 75 popular songs from various genres and decades. Each player is given a bingo card which has a bingo board of 5x5 squares containing the title/artist of the songs being played. The middle square on the board is like a joker and is also used in the game.



As songs from this playlist are played, they are marked off on the bingo board, and when one of the players has marked off all 24 songs on the bingo board, a winner can be chosen. Here you can also be creative to, for example, have bingo on one line, two lines, corner, horizontal, vertical, diagonal etc.

A good tip is to set Spotify playback to random, that way you will always get a random playback and unique completion of the music bingo.

Usually, it is enough to play about 60 seconds of a song, but it may also be a good idea to control it by verse and chorus, e.g. play until the first chorus is finished. Normally, around 60 songs must be played to achieve bingo (full board), but this depends on how many boards are played. When hosting a music bingo game, it is crucial to adapt the tempo to the group of players participating.

In addition to the bingo boards, it also comes with a PDF file with an overview of the songs, as well as a link and QR code to the Spotify list.

A small tip is that you check off this playlist as songs are played, and in that way, you have a slightly easier task when you control whether it is a valid bingo or not.
