

Music Bingo Quiz 30 How To Play

Music Bingo Quiz 30 is a fun and exciting twist on the classic bingo game, with 30 popular songs from various genres and decades. Each player receives a bingo card with four 3×3 bingo boards. The bingo cards are distributed so that in the top two containers you will find the song and artist, while the two bottom containers contain answers to the quiz question.

You have also received a link to a Spotify playlist that is adapted to the music bingo.

As songs are played from this playlist, there is also a quiz question for the song, you can find this on the song list, which is asked to those who play. If you have the song that is played on one of the bingo boards, you mark this off, and you also have to control if you have the answer to the question on one of the boards at the bottom of the sheet - and mark off here as well. Please note that even if the song is not on the bingo board, the answer to the quiz question may still be on the bingo board.

The first player to fill one of the boards with 9 crosses is the winner.

A good tip is to set Spotify playback to random, that way you will always get a random playback and unique completion of the music bingo.

Usually, it is enough to play about 60 seconds of a song, but it may also be a good idea to control it by verse and chorus, e.g. play until the first chorus is finished. Normally, more than 20 songs must be played to achieve bingo, but this depends on how many boards are played. When hosting a music bingo game, it is crucial to adapt the tempo to the group of players participating.

In addition to the bingo boards, it also comes with a PDF file with an overview of the songs, as well as a link and QR code to the Spotify list.

A small tip is that you check off this playlist as songs are played, and in that way, you have a slightly easier task when you control whether it is a valid bingo or not.

If this music bingo has access to digital bingo boards, you should have received a six-digit code. Those who want to play music bingo then go to www.musikk-bingo.no and enter the six-digit code, and they will then have a bingo board available on their mobile.
